Forms

Students will preform their designated form individually by division. Students will be judged on accuracy based on USAT rules, snap, and timing. Students who tie will preform their form at the same time and judges will decide by a hand vote.

Breaking

Boards must be purchased at event. 5 stations. Simultaneous breaks count for one station. Combinations count as two or more stations. Students will have two attempts to break each station; any attempts after will not be counted. Students will have up to 2 minutes to set up, break, and clean up. Props are not permitted for breaking. Competitors are responsible for supplying their own holders. Ties will be decided by judge's agreement. Scoring will be based on control, speed, rhythm, use of Taekwondo skills and performance. Breaking boards will be 10"X12"X1/2".

Sparring

Sparring will be judged by Current USAT rules. Daedo Electronic Sparring Gear will be used. All gear must be WT approved. Glasses of any sort, and face shields are not permitted. All competitors must have a: Helmet, Mouth guard (No Red) Arm, Trunk, Cup, Leg, and Foot Protectors. TKD gloves are optional for color belts. Black belts must wear them. Student's nails must be trimmed, and hair must be up. Students who do not have the proper equipment and are not maintained will be given 1 minute to address the issue or be disqualified. Ties will be decided by golden point. No head contact under 12 years old. 12 – 17 years old, light head contact. 18+ Controlled head contact. USAT Junior Safety Rules will be strictly enforced.

Tournament will be located in the rear of the mall in the old JCPenny's. Please refer to posted signs off of 322 as you enter the mall complex.
